

Environmental, Health, Safety and Quality (EHSQ) Policy

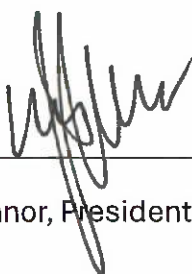
At Buckman, employee safety and health, environmental stewardship, and the quality of our products are integral to how we do business. We are committed to:

- An effective Quality Management System (QMS), by consistently supplying products and services that comply with applicable customer and regulatory requirements, and enhancing customer satisfaction.

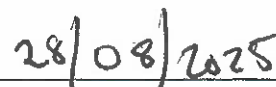
We will achieve these by:
